2012 Delaware All-State Jazz Band Chris Vadala—Guest Conductor



One of the country's foremost woodwind artists, Chris Vadala is in demand as a jazz/classical performer and educator. He has appeared on more than 100 recordings to date, as well as innumerable jingle sessions, film and TV scores, performing on all the saxophones, flutes, and clarinets. A native of Poughkeepsie, N.Y., he graduated from the Eastman School of Music, earning the honor of the Performer's Certificate in saxophone as well as a B.M. in Music Education, received an M.A. in clarinet from Connecticut College, and pursued postgraduate study in woodwinds at Eastman.

Professor Vadala, Director of Jazz Studies and Saxophone Professor, is a UM 2010 Distinguished Scholar-Teacher at the University of Maryland. Previous academic appointments include teaching studio woodwinds and conducting jazz ensembles at Connecticut College, Montgomery College, Hampton University, Prince George's Community College and Mount Vernon College, as well as Visiting Professor of Saxophone at the Eastman School of Music in 1995 and 2001.

Mr. Vadala's performing career has been highlighted by a long tenure as standout woodwind artist with the internationally recognized Chuck Mangione Quartet, which included performances in all 50 states, Canada, Australia, Japan, Phillipines, China, Brazil, Mexico, Argentina, Bermuda, Puerto Rico, Virgin Islands, Dominican Republic, England, Italy, France, Germany, Austria, Netherlands, Poland, Belgium, and Switzerland, and performing credits on five gold and two platinum albums, plus two Grammy, one Emmy, one Georgie (AGVA) and one Golden Globe Award. In addition, he has performed and/or recorded with such greats as Dizzy Gillespie, Quincy Jones, B.B. King, Chick Corea, Ella Fitzgerald, Aretha Franklin, Placido Domingo, Sarah Vaughan, Natalie Cole, Herbie Hancock, Ray Charles, Stevie Wonder, Henry Mancini, Doc Severinsen, Joe Lovano, and many others. As of 2009, he became a regular member of the Award-Winning

Smithsonian Jazz Masterworks Orchestra, and has been the first call saxophonist with National Symphony Orchestra for many years.

As one of the Selmer Company's most requested Artist in Residence clinicians, Mr. Vadala travels worldwide, performing with and conducting student and professional jazz ensembles, symphonic bands, and orchestras. He has appeared with countless musical ensembles across the nation and Canada, and has conducted 47 All-State, 1 All-Eastern, as well as numerous All-County and All-District Jazz Ensembles. Mr. Vadala served three terms as President of the Maryland Unit of the International Association for Jazz Education, was a permanent member of its MD Executive Board (College Faculty Representative), and a Woodwind Representative to the International Resource Team.

Mr. Vadala's column on woodwind doubling appeared regularly in the Saxophone Journal for over 10 years, and he has authored articles for many other magazines. A *Downbeat* magazine poll finalist in four categories and the recipient of a National Endowment for the Arts Jazz Study grant, he has published a number of original compositions and arrangements (Medici Music & Cimarron Music Press). His book, *Improve Your Doubling* (Dorn Productions), is acclaimed as a valuable addition to woodwind literature. In addition to his debut solo CD, *Out of the Shadows* (Art of Life Records), recent recording/publications include *Jazz/Rock in the USA*, *Jazz Solos*, *Nothin' But Jazz*, *Jazz Adventures*, *Modern Jazz-Rock and R & B*, and *Fusion Solos* (6 books with play-a-long CDs by De Haske/Curnow), as well as a contributions to Warner Brother's *Approaching the Standards* play-a-long improvisation series and *Jazz Pedagogy* (*The Jazz Educator's Handbook and Resource Guide*). He also has the honor of being included in a new publication, "The History of the Top 40 Sax Solos (1955-1998)."

Stephen Holmes began his formal musical training with The Maryland State Boychoir (MSB) at the age of nine. His strong ties and commitment to the MSB continue today where he is now serving in his fourteenth year on staff and serves as the Artistic Director, overseeing the boychoir's six ensembles. Mr. Holmes serves in various leadership roles throughout the Maryland and D.C. area. He is currently the Director of Choral Activities at the Notre Dame of Maryland University. He has also served as Associate Director of the Glorystar Children's Choir. In addition, he is the Organist/Choirmaster at the Church of the Resurrection and for ten years served in the same position at Aisquith Presbyterian Church in Baltimore. Mr. Holmes also conducted the University of Maryland Men's chorus from 2005-2011. Additionally, he serves on the board of directors for the Canticale Singers of Baltimore, the Maryland State Boychoir, and The Choral Music Educators Association of Maryland. Mr. Holmes has conducted in 35 states and at the ACDA and Maryland Music Educators Association conferences, served as a guest conductor of county and state honor choirs and festivals, and his choral arrangements have been performed by choirs throughout the country. Mr. Holmes has performed as a soloist and chorister with numerous regional ensembles and has been recognized with several voice, organ, and conducting awards. Mr. Holmes and his wife and newborn daughter reside in Baltimore's Mayfield community. He received his Bachelor of Music degree in voice and organ performance from Towson University and his Masters degree in Choral Conducting from the University of Maryland, College Park. He will complete his doctorate in choral conducting at the University of Maryland in the spring of 2012.

Sun Min Lee—Guest Conductor

Lori Geckle—Accompanist



Sun Min Lee is the conductor of the Rider University Chorale in Lawrenceville, New Jersey. Before this appointment, she served for six years as a member of the choral conducting faculty at Rider University's Westminster Choir College, where she conducted the Westminster Chapel Choir. Under her direction, the Chapel Choir made its debut in Carnegie Hall in 2010. She has also conducted the Westminster Schola Cantorum and the Westminster Symphonic Choir and taught both undergraduate and graduate conducting courses. While in her residency at Westminster Choir College, Ms. Lee collaborated with many renowned guest conductors, including Anton Armstrong, Stephen Paulus, Kathy Romey, Dale Warland, Mark Laycock, Fernando Raucci, and Peter Bagley. Ms. Lee also worked with Lorin Maazel in the performance of Mozart's *Coronation Mass* with the New York Philharmonic Orchestra.

As a guest conductor, clinician and lecturer, she has appeared with numerous all-state choirs, county festival honors choirs, conducting workshops, and master classes. Her most recent appearance was as the conductor of the 2011 North Carolina High School Honors Chorus.

Ms. Lee holds a Bachelor of Church Music from the Presbyterian College and Theological Seminary in South Korea and a Master of Music in Choral Conducting with distinction from Westminster Choir College, where she studied with Joseph Flummerfelt. Prior to coming to the United States, she received an advanced diploma in Kodaly's music pedagogy from the Zoltán Kodály Pedagogical Institute of Music in Kecskemét, Hungary, where she studied with Péter Erdei.

From 2001 to 2003, she was on the conducting faculty at Hobart and William Smith colleges in Geneva, New York. Ms. Lee has pursued doctoral studies at the Eastman School of Music, where she studied with William Weinert.

In 2011, Ms. Lee was appointed associate conductor of the Masterwork Chorus, one of the leading community choruses in New Jersey. Last December, she prepared the chorus for performances with the New Jersey Symphony Orchestra under the direction of Constantine Kitsopoulos.

Steven Sametz—Guest Conductor
David Schelat—Accompanist



Steven Sametz has earned increasing renown in recent years as both composer and conductor. He is the Ronald J. Ulrich Professor of Music and director of Lehigh University Choral Arts, one of the country's premiere choral programs. He also serves as Artistic Director for the elite a cappella ensemble, The Princeton Singers, and is the founding director of The Lehigh University Choral Composer Forum, a summer course of study designed to mentor emerging choral composers.

Recent guest conducting appearances include the Taipei Philharmonic Foundation, the Berkshire Music Festival, the New York Chamber Symphony, and the Netherlands Radio Choir. Dr. Sametz' compositions have been heard throughout the world at the Tanglewood, Ravinia, Salzburg, Schleswig-Holstein, and Santa Fe music festivals. His *in time of* appears on the recent Grammy award-winning CD by Chanticleer, "Colors of Love," and his work may be heard on six other Chanticleer CDs, as well as Lehigh University Choir's "Live from Taipei," Lehigh University Choral Arts' "What Wondrous Love is This," The Princeton Singers' "Reincarnations," "Christmas with the Princeton Singers," and "Old, New Borrowed, Blues," a collection of his choral arrangements and compositions featuring guest artists Chanticleer in collaboration with The Princeton Singers performing his *Dudaryku — A Village Scene*, written for these two groups.

Most recently, Dr. Sametz conducted The Princeton Singers at the American Choral Directors Association convention in Pittsburg, the American Guild of Organists convention in Philadelphia, and the Chorus America conference in Washington, D.C.

Dr. Sametz has received commissions from the National Endowment for the Arts, the Connecticut Council on the Arts, and the Santa Fe Music Festival, creating new works for Chanticleer, the Dale Warland Singers, Philadelphia Singers, Pro Arte Chamber Choir, the Santa Fe Desert Chorale, Connecticut Choral Artists, and the King of Thailand. His compositions are published by Oxford University Press, Alliance Music, ECS Publishing, GIA, and Steven Sametz Publications.

Dr. Sametz has served as panelist for the National Endowment for the Arts and Chorus America. He has been Director of Choral Activities at Harvard and is the founder and director of the Lehigh University Choral Union. At the Santa Fe Music Festival, he conducted his own works in a program entitled “Sametz conducts Sametz.” He has conducted Chanticleer in the Monteverdi *Vespers of 1610* in New York and San Francisco to critical acclaim. Dr. Sametz holds degrees from Yale University, the University of Wisconsin-Madison, and the Hochschule für Musik und darstellende Kunst in Frankfurt, Germany.

2012 Delaware All-State Junior Band Paula A. Crider—Guest Conductor



Following a distinguished 33 year teaching career, Professor Paula A. Crider continues to share her passion for making music through an active schedule as guest conductor, lecturer, clinician and adjudicator. She has enjoyed engagements in 48 states, Canada, Ireland, the United Kingdom, France, Singapore, Italy, Germany, Spain and Australia. She is Professor Emerita at The University of Texas where she was twice awarded the “Eyes of Texas” Award for distinguished teaching.

Professor Crider has taught in the public schools at all levels, and holds the unique distinction of having been the first female in the state of Texas to serve as director of bands at a class 5-A high school. Her Crockett High School Bands in Austin, Texas earned twelve consecutive University Interscholastic League “Sweepstakes Awards” for musical excellence, received national recognition on the concert stage, and were twice named Texas 5A State Marching Champions.

During her tenure at The University of Texas, Professor Crider conducted the Symphony Band, the Longhorn Marching and Concert Bands, served as instructor for undergraduate conducting, Brass Methods, Graduate Wind Literature, supervised student teachers and served as administrator for the Longhorn Music Camps. Highly acclaimed for its musical and marching excellence, the 380 member Longhorn Bands enjoyed national acclaim under her leadership. She continues to serve as visiting guest professor at universities throughout the country.

Prof. Crider has written numerous articles for *The Instrumentalist*, *The Band Director’s Guide*, and the *National Band Association Journal*. She has published manuals for Brass Techniques, Marching Band Methods and Instrumental Conducting, and is co-author for the Hal Leonard “Masterwork Studies” series, a

text for high school bands. She has recently completed *The Composer's Legacy, Conductors on Conducting for Wind Band* published by GIA.

Prof. Crider has presented professional teacher seminars throughout the United States, and is the Chief Adjudicator for the London New Year's Day Parade. She serves as coordinator for the National Band Association Young Conductor/Mentor Program, is an Educational Consultant for Conn-Selmer, Inc., and was recently appointed to the Midwest International Band and Orchestra Board. Prof. Crider is a Past President of the National Band Association, and the American Bandmaster's Association.

Awards and honors include the Tau Beta Sigma/Kappa Kappa Psi "Outstanding Service to Music Award," the Sudler "Legion of Merit," The Women Band Director's International Rose, The Grainger Society Medal, the Kappa Kappa Psi Bo Makvosky Memorial Award, the National Band Association AWAPA Award, 2004 Texas Bandmaster of the Year, and the Midwest Medal of Honor. She considers her greatest honor, however, to be the privilege of working with all who share a passion for excellence in making music.

2012 Delaware All-State Senior Band Andrew Boysen, Jr.—Guest Conductor



Andrew Boysen, Jr. is presently a professor in the music department at the University of New Hampshire, where he conducts the wind symphony and teaches conducting and composition. Previously, Boysen served as an assistant professor and Acting Associate Director of Bands at Indiana State University, where he directed the Marching Sycamores, conducted the symphonic band and taught in the music education department. Prior to that appointment, he was the Director of Bands at Cary-Grove (IL) High School and was the music director and conductor of the Deerfield Community Concert Band. He remains active as a guest conductor and clinician, appearing with high school, university and festival ensembles across the United States, Great Britain, and Australia.

Boysen earned his Doctor of Musical Arts degree in wind conducting at the Eastman School of Music, where he served as conductor of the Eastman Wind Orchestra and assistant conductor of the Eastman Wind Ensemble. He received his Master of Music degree in wind conducting from Northwestern University in 1993 and his Bachelor of Music degree in music education and music composition from the University of Iowa in 1991.

He maintains an active schedule as a composer, receiving commissions from the Herbert Hoover Presidential Library, the Cedar Rapids Metropolitan Orchestra Festival, the Iowa All-State Band, the Rhode Island All-State Band, the Nebraska State Bandmasters Association, and many university and high school concert bands across the United States. Boysen won the International Horn Society Composition Contest in 2000, the University of Iowa Honors Composition Prize in 1991 and has twice won the Claude T. Smith Memorial Band Composition Contest, in 1991 and 1994. Boysen has several published works with the Neil A. Kjos Music Company, Wingert-Jones Music, Alfred Music, Masters Music, and

C. Alan Publications, including pieces for band, orchestra, clarinet and piano, and brass choir. Recordings of his music appear on the Sony, R-Kal, Mark, St. Olaf and Elf labels.

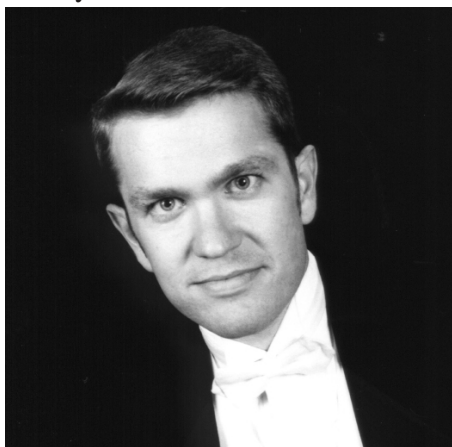

Dr. Timothy Dixon is Director of Orchestral Studies and Associate Professor of Music at Messiah College (PA), where he conducts the orchestras and musical theater productions, provides leadership to the string area and is the lead teacher of the M.M. in Orchestral Conducting program. Off campus, Dixon is also the Music Director / Conductor of the West Shore Symphony Orchestra (PA) and a regular conductor of the Harrisburg Opera Association. Active nationally and internationally, Dixon has conducted numerous regional and all-state orchestras, as well as the Buffalo Philharmonic Orchestra, the Norwalk Symphony Orchestra (CT), and professional orchestras in Germany and Ukraine.

Before moving to Pennsylvania, Dixon served as conductor of the University of Iowa Philharmonia Orchestra, and the Preucil School String Orchestra, an ensemble which has been featured on public radio and television as well as in international festivals and tours. Timothy Dixon has also served as the Music Director/Conductor of the Middletown Youth Symphony (OH), the Saginaw Bay Youth Orchestra (MI), the Michigan State University Musical Theater Department, and the Michigan State University Campus Orchestra. Dixon also served as string educator, grades 4-12, in the Middletown City School District (OH).

Timothy Dixon holds the Doctor of Musical Arts in Orchestral Conducting from the University of Iowa, the M.M. in Orchestral Conducting from Michigan State University, and a B.A. and B.M. in Music and Music Education, respectively, from Miami University (OH).
