Sophia Miller, Assistant Conductor of the award-winning Young People's Chorus of New York City, is the principal conductor of the Prelude chorus and assists with YPC's other divisions. She has served as director of YPC's College Bound program for six years, created by YPC to provide choristers with such support as professional tutoring, the college search, and the college application process to help ensure that 100% of YPC graduates go on to higher education. Since joining YPC in 2007, Ms. Miller has conducted at Carnegie Hall, Avery Fisher Hall, Lincoln Center's Rose Theater, the 92nd Street Y, Merkin Concert Hall at Kaufman Center, and Symphony Space. She has prepared YPC choruses for national radio and television appearances, recording sessions, and for performances not only in New York City, but also in major venues throughout North America, Asia, Europe, and South America for YPC's global tours. Outside of YPC, Ms. Miller is an active studio recording artist for commercial, film and choral demos, and serves as a member of the board of directors for the Foundation for Small Voices, dedicated, through music, to crossing cultural, generational, and ideological boundaries to raise awareness and funds for national and international music and mentoring programs for children. As a choral clinician, she gives workshops and guest-conducts throughout the United States. Ms. Miller is a magna cum laude graduate of the Ithaca College School of Music where she is a member of the Choral Music Experience artistic faculty.

Dr. Yu holds a Bachelor of Music degree in music education from the University of Central Oklahoma, Master of Music degree in choral conducting from Oklahoma State University, and the Doctorate of Musical Arts degree in choral conducting from the University of North Texas.

Before joining the Kansas State faculty, Dr. Yu taught at Norman North High School in Norman, Oklahoma and San José State University.

She has conducted honor choirs in Kansas, Oklahoma, Texas, Virginia, and Germany. She has given presentations and her choirs have performed for the Southwest American Choral Directors Association and the European Music Educators Association Conventions. She serves as Repertoire and Standards Chair for Youth and Student Activities for the Southwest American Choral Directors Association and is a National Board Member of the National Collegiate Choral Organization.

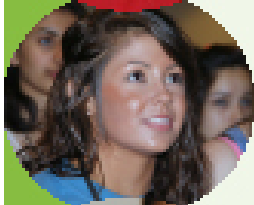
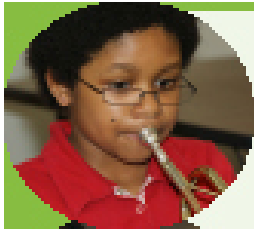

Vijay Singh is an active performer, composer, teacher, conductor, and clinician residing in Ellensburg, Washington where he is Professor of Music at Central Washington University. A graduate of Willamette University (B. M. Ed/Clarinet & Voice) and Portland State University (Masters in Choral Conducting/Vocal Performance), he has been rapidly gaining international attention for his eclectic musical compositions, performances, workshops, and conducting appearances. Vijay's teaching experiences have included work at public secondary schools, community college, and university levels. He currently teaches voice, choral arranging, jazz pedagogy, directs the University Chorale, and award-winning CWU Vocal Jazz 1, and oversees the vocal jazz program (3 jazz choirs). Vijay's student ensembles at CWU have been honored as some of the finest in the nation with invitations to perform at prestigious national IAJE, MENC, and ACDA conventions. Vocal Jazz 1 performed at the national ACDA conference in Chicago, IL March 11, 2011, and most recently, at the 2013 national Jazz Education Network (JEN) conference in Atlanta, GA. As a composer, Vijay writes for all levels in both the classical choral and jazz idioms. His compositions (over 170 currently in print) are widely available from a number of publishers and he often writes on commission for some of North America's finest ensembles. Vijay's "MASS with Orchestra" received its world premiere at Lincoln Center in New York City May 30th, 2011.

An active performer, Vijay has appeared as featured bass-baritone soloist with such notable groups as Male Ensemble Northwest, Choral Cross Ties, the Oregon Symphony, the Robert Shaw Chorale, David Byrne (Talking Heads), Clark

Terry, the Disciples of Groove, and as a member of the award-winning a cappella jazz quartet Just 4 Kicks. He has appeared in professional opera and musical theatre productions, and maintains an active career in oratorio, recital, and contemporary music.

Vijay served 4 years as National Repertoire and Standards Chair for Jazz Choirs in the American Choral Director’s Association and is in demand as a guest conductor of All-State and Honors choirs. He has conducted All-State choirs in over twenty-five states and has the distinction of conducting both All-State Concert Choirs and Jazz Choirs within the same year. Vijay has served as adjudicator/jurist at international festivals in Canada, the Netherlands, Germany, and the United States. The recent recipient of a thirteenth ASCAP Composer’s Award, Vijay is also a member of ACDA, MENC/NAfME, ASCAP, JEN and the National Association of Teachers of Singing.

After his seventeen-year worldwide touring and recording stint with the Jazz Ambassadors, the premiere touring jazz ensemble of the US Army, Jim retired from the military in 1998 to find a variety of projects awaiting him. As a freelance musician, he has been performing in an incredibly diverse array of situations. These include a 3-year run with Chuck Brown, Washington, DC's "Godfather of Go-Go," appearances with the Baltimore Symphony Pops Orchestra, the critically acclaimed Great American Music Ensemble, and the Kennedy Center Orchestra. Jim's recording credits include more than 100 projects as a featured soloist as well as numerous national television spots. Currently, Jim is a regular member of the internationally renowned Capitol Bones as well as Lubbock, a 10-piece improvisational ensemble based in Baltimore. He has appeared on "Late Night with Conan O'Brien" with Thievery Corporation, a DC-based techno band and continues to tour extensively throughout the United States and Europe.

Today, Jim is in great demand as both a trombonist and educator. 2014 Delaware All-State Junior Band Robert Sheldon—Guest Conductor



Robert Sheldon (b. Feb 3, 1954) has taught instrumental music in the Florida and Illinois public schools, and has served on the faculty at Florida State University where he taught conducting and instrumental music education classes, and directed the university bands. As Concert Band Editor for Alfred Music Publishing, he maintains an active composition and conducting schedule, and regularly accepts commissions for new works. Sheldon received the Bachelor of Music in Music Education from the University of Miami and the Master of Fine Arts in Instrumental Conducting from the University of Florida.

An internationally recognized clinician, Sheldon has conducted numerous Regional and All-State Honor Bands throughout the United States and abroad. His teaching career included 28 years in the Florida and Illinois public schools as well as at the University of Florida, Florida State University, Illinois Central College and Bradley University. He also held positions as conductor of the Alachua County Youth Orchestra in Gainesville, Florida and the Prairie Wind Ensemble in East Peoria, Illinois. He maintains membership in several organizations that promote music and music education. He is lead author for the *Sound Innovations for Band* method books, and is a co-author for the *Measures of Success Volume 1* method book and the *Sound Innovations for Strings* method books.

The American School Band Directors Association has honored him with the Volkwein Award for composition and the Stanbury Award for teaching, and the International Assembly of Phi Beta Mu honored him with the International Outstanding Bandmaster Award. He has also been a twenty-five-time recipient of the American Society of Composers, Authors and Publisher's Standard Award for his compositions in the concert band and orchestral repertoire. His compositions

have been recorded and released on compact discs including, *Images: The Music of Robert Sheldon*, and *Infinite Horizons: The Music of Robert Sheldon*, as well as numerous other recordings. Mr. Sheldon has been the topic of articles published in *The Instrumentalist*, *Teaching Music*, and *School Band and Orchestra Magazine*, and is one of eleven American wind band composers featured in Volume I of *Composers on Composing Music for Band*.

Access the Status Quo

- Study the ways that music education develops creativity, enhances cooperative learning, instills disciplined work habits, and statistically correlates with gains in standardized test scores.
- Speak with your local school board about your desire to have a strong music education for your child.
- Find out if music classes in your schools are taught by teachers certified in the arts; see to it that arts specialists are required by policy.

Communicate Effectively

- Speak at meetings of your school board about the importance of supporting music education with funds for teacher training, equipment and supplies, and music-related activities.
- Be in touch with local music teachers on a regular basis.
- Ask yourself why your children need high quality music education. Be able to articulate the answers to teachers, administrators, and other parents.
- Take part in your school's music booster organization.
- Make certain that your local media give adequate coverage to the accomplishments of your school's music program.
