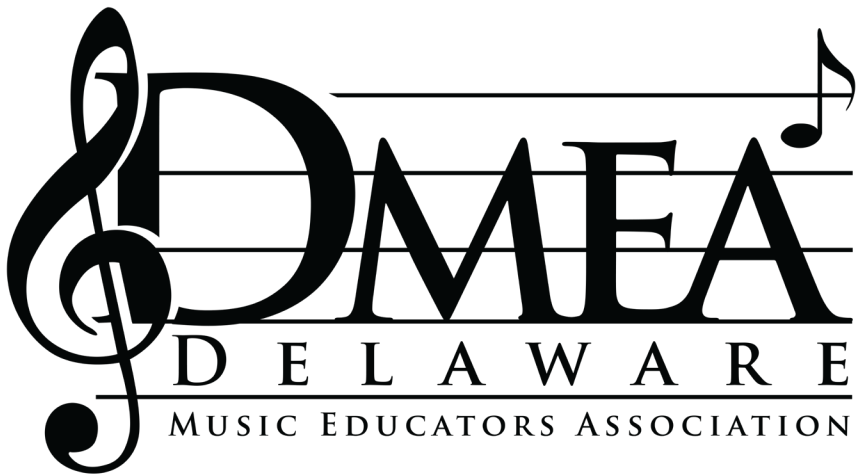

Mrs. Kimberley Ahrens is in her fifteenth year of teaching in Plano ISD, thirteen of which have been as choral director at Robinson Middle School, where she conducts over 250 students in a total of seven performing ensembles. Choirs under her direction have consistently earned Sweepstakes awards at UIL Concert and Sight Reading Contest and have been successful at various other competitions throughout the state of Texas and the nation. In 2013 and 2018 Mrs. Ahrens had choirs selected to perform at the Texas Music Educators Association Convention, and in 2014 her choir performed at the MS/JH National Conference for Choral Music. In addition to her full-time teaching duties, Mrs. Ahrens has served as conductor for the Apprentice Chorus of The Children's Chorus of Greater Dallas since 2013 and as Director of Children's Choirs at Transfiguration Episcopal Church in Dallas since 2008. She has also served as an adjunct professor in the music education departments of Southern Methodist University and the University of North Texas.

In 2009 Kimberley received the Texas Choral Directors Association Distinguished Young Director Award, and in 2013 she was named Teacher of the Year at Robinson Middle School. She continues to serve as a clinician and consultant for music teachers, conductors, and singers throughout the state of Texas. She is also a frequent guest conductor, appearing by invitation with youth choirs across the country.

Mrs. Ahrens earned the Bachelor of Music Education degree from Texas Christian University and holds certification in Kodály method from the University of North Texas. She holds affiliations with the American Choral Directors Association, Texas Choral Directors Association, and Texas Music Education Association. Mrs. Ahrens lives in McKinney, Texas, with her husband Chris, daughter Katherine, son Camden, and their two dogs, Jake and Bandit.

Greg Gilpin began piano lessons at the age of four and while continuing his music study in piano, trumpet, French horn and voice, he became an accomplished accompanist in middle school, high school and college. By the time he attended university, he had also directed a church choir for four years. His first choral works were published while attending Northwest Missouri State University, where he received his degree in Vocal Music Education.

Mr. Gilpin resides in Indianapolis, Indiana and since 1986, his career has been and continues to be musically diverse. In addition to his work in music education, he has traveled internationally as a back-up singer for various artists, in demand studio musician and producer and is a well-known ASCAP award-winning composer and arranger. He is a highly respected choral conductor throughout the United States and internationally including the respected and historic venues of Carnegie Hall, Lincoln Center and Harpa Concert Hall in Reykjavik, Iceland. Mr. Gilpin also enjoys conducting educational choral tours for singers of all ages to various locations, including Washington DC, Ireland and Hawaii, learning and appreciating culture and history while making beautiful music together as a choral ensemble.

He is currently Director of Educational Choral Publications for Shawnee Press, a well-known and respected choral publisher and is a mem-

ber of ACDA, NAfME, SAG-AFTRA, and is a Life Loyal Member of Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia.

Rollo Dilworth is Professor of Choral Music Education and Vice Dean at Temple University's Center for the Performing and Cinematic Arts in Philadelphia, PA. He has served on the faculty since 2009. Prior to his position with Boyer College, he taught music education and was the director of choral activities for 13 years at North Park University in Chicago, where he prepared and conducted numerous extended and choral-orchestral works. Before teaching at the college level, Dilworth also taught choral and general music at the middle school level in his hometown of St. Louis, MO.

Over 200 of Dilworth's choral compositions and arrangements have been published, and can be found in the catalogs of Hal Leonard Corporation, Santa Barbara Music Publishers and Colla Voce Music. He is also the author of 3 choral pedagogy books entitled *Choir Builders*. Dilworth has conducted 57 all-state choirs ranging across various levels, 7 regional honor choirs, and 4 national honor choirs. For the 2019-2020 season, Dilworth has been invited to conduct all-state and honor choirs in Delaware, Maine and Texas. International festival and clinic invitations include China and Korea.

2020 Delaware All-State Jazz Ensemble James Moore—Guest Conductor



Dr. James Moore, Dean of the Faculty and Chief Academic Officer at West Virginia Wesleyan College, served as Director of Jazz Ensembles and instructor of trumpet at Wesleyan from 2006 to 2017. From 2011 to 2017, he served as the chairperson of the Department of Music at Wesleyan and has worked to build one of the most vibrant collegiate jazz programs in the region.

Dr. Moore is an active member of the Pittsburgh jazz community where he is a member of the Pittsburgh Jazz Orchestra and has been a member of RH Factor—the Roger Humphries quintet. In addition to his work in Pittsburgh he performs regularly with the Norman David Eleventet in Philadelphia as well as many other collaborative ventures in that city. He has performed with the Smithsonian Jazz Masterworks Orchestra, the Bob Mintzer Big Band, Toshiko Akiyoshi, Ahmad Jamal, Sheryl Bailey, Tim Warfield, and the Lars Halle Jazz Orchestra. Moore appeared on Bob Mintzer's GRAMMY nominated album *For the Moment*, released on the MCG Jazz label in 2012. He also appears on Mintzer's joint album with the critically acclaimed New York Voices, *Meeting of Minds (Live)*, also on MCG Jazz. In 2015, Moore appeared alongside NEA Jazz Master Phil Woods and the Pittsburgh Symphony Orchestra in a reprisal of the famous Charlie Parker and Clifford Brown with strings recordings.

Moore is also an active clinician, having worked with many high school honors jazz ensembles throughout Pennsylvania and Western Maryland. He has presented master classes at countless high schools and colleges throughout the nation. He is also a member of the Artist Faculty of the National Trumpet Competition, as well as serving on the research review board of the International Trumpet Guild. His articles on jazz trumpet

pedagogy have been published by the Australian and International Trumpet Guilds.

Moore studied trumpet with Bonnie Miltenberger, Neil Stalaker, John Swana, and Tim Hagans. He holds an MM in Jazz Studies from the University of the Arts in Philadelphia, and is the first recipient of the PhD in Jazz Studies from the University of Pittsburgh where his advisor was Dr. Nathan T. Davis—founder of the original Pittsburgh Jazz Orchestra.

Dr. Andrew Yozviak is the Director of Bands at West Chester University. His primary responsibilities include conducting the Wind Ensemble and Chamber Winds, and teaching graduate conducting classes. Prior to this appointment, Yozviak served as Visiting Director of Bands at Susquehanna University and taught thirteen years in the Pennsylvania public schools.

Dr. Yozviak has earned a Bachelor of Science Degree in Music Education from West Chester University of Pennsylvania and a Master of Music Degree in Composition from Indiana University, Bloomington, Indiana, and a Doctorate of Musical Arts Degree in Wind Conducting from Rutgers University where he studied with William Berz.

Under Yozviak's direction, WCU ensembles have performed at CBDNA national and divisional conferences as well as PMEA and NAFME conferences. These ensembles have had regular tour performances throughout Europe and most recently a performance as part of the 2018 Beijing International Arts Festival in China.

Dr. Yozviak maintains a busy schedule as a guest conductor, adjudicator and clinician, regularly presenting at conferences and workshops. His research in the area of eighteenth-century *Harmoniemusik* has produced two modern editions of wind partitas by the Bohemian composer, Antonio Rosetti (1750-1792). Most recently, Dr. Yozviak has completed a transcription for wind dectet of Rosetti's *Concerto for Two Horns* (spurious-

ly attributed to Franz Joseph Haydn). The work was recorded in the spring of 2014.

As a composer, Dr. Yozviak has accepted commissions to compose and arrange music in a variety of genres including works for winds, chorus, jazz ensemble, and a variety of chamber ensembles. Dr. Yozviak's work as an arranger has yielded more than three hundred marching band shows for high school and university bands, drum and bugle corps and work for NFL Films. His compositions and arrangements are published by North-east Music Publications, Center X Productions and his scholarly edition of Antonio Rosetti's *Partita in E-flat* is published by Amadeus Verlag, Winterthur, Switzerland.

Dr. Yozviak is a member of the College Band Directors National Association, the World Association for Symphonic Bands and Ensembles, the National Band Association, the National Association for Music Education, Pennsylvania Music Educators Association, Pi Kappa Lambda, Phi Beta Mu and Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia. He is an honorary member of Kappa Kappa Psi fraternity, Tau Beta Sigma sorority and Sigma Alpha sorority.
