

## JOEY TARTELL

### GUEST CONDUCTOR

Joey Tartell is Professor of Trumpet and the Director of Undergraduate Studies at Indiana University's Jacobs School of Music. Before joining the faculty, he enjoyed a career as an in-demand lead and free lance trumpet player. Joey was the lead player for Maynard Ferguson, touring the United States, Australia, Asia, and Europe, and can be heard on the recording "These Cats Can Swing." He also played lead for the Smithsonian Jazz Masterworks Orchestra, including a State Department tour of Egypt; the U.S. Army Jazz Ambassadors, including a State Department tour of India and appearances at the Montreux and North Sea Jazz Festivals; and the Glenn Miller Orchestra.

Although teaching full time, Mr. Tartell remains an active performer. He is a regular guest lead trumpet/soloist with several orchestras for Pops concerts, including serving as the Guest Principal for the Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra's entire 2014-15 Pops season. Joey has also played with the Chicago, Cleveland, St. Louis, Houston, Cincinnati, Detroit, National Arts Centre (Ottawa), and Baltimore Symphony Orchestras. Also active in the recording studios, he has recorded for the Bob and Tom Show, Hal Leonard Publications, Shawnee Press, Cedar Point Amusement Park, Williams Gaming, and many others. Joey has also toured with Boston Brass and Canadian Brass.

Mr. Tartell is also active as a soloist and clinician. Recently, he has been a featured soloist and clinician at both the International Trumpet Guild conference and the National Trumpet Competition.

Joey has a Master's degree in Jazz Studies from the University of Miami, and a Bachelor of Music degree from the Eastman School of Music, where he was also awarded a Performer's Certificate. He had the great fortune to study with Barbara Butler, Mel Broiles, Gil Johnson, and Vince DiMartino.



# LAUREN CONRAD

## GUEST CONDUCTOR

Dr. Lauren Conrad serves as the Education Associate for Visual & Performing Arts for the Delaware Department of Education. In this role, Dr. Conrad oversees arts programming in public and charter schools in the state. She works to provide high quality professional learning experiences for arts educators and guidance through an arts lens with the Curriculum, Instruction, and Professional Development workgroup at the DOE, serves on the Equity Committee, the MTSS (Multi-Tiered System of Supports) Advisory committee, the SEL (Social-Emotional Learning) Core Team and Advisory Team and also acts as a liaison for gifted services.

Prior to her new role at the DDOE, Dr. Conrad taught vocal music education for 15 years, most recently at Concord High School in Wilmington Delaware. Her primary role was to encourage human self-expression and academic excellence from her students through multiple choral ensembles. Music was always a huge part of her life, as both of her parents were professional singers. It was her experiences in choirs both in high school and college as well as the teachers leading them that shaped her life. As a result, music education became her passion.

Dr. Conrad earned her Doctorate in Educational Leadership and Innovation from Wilmington University in 2019, her Masters of Music in choral conducting and teaching certification from the University of Delaware in 2005, and her Bachelor of Music in applied voice from the University of Delaware in 2003. She believes that lifelong learning is

imperative to the success of educators, illustrating to students that their teachers want to be the best for them both in and outside of the classroom.

Dr. Conrad continues to serve on the board of the Delaware Music Educators Association, Delaware Chapter of the American Choral Directors Association, is a member of Delaware Art Educators Association, and serves as a member of the LEAD team for the Delaware Arts Alliance. When not advocating for arts education, Dr. Conrad continues to sing professionally, most recently appearing with the University of Delaware Master Player Concert Series in their Music 113 performance “Burning Ice.”

Dr. Conrad lives in Swarthmore, Pennsylvania where she spends any free time with her family, friends, and fur “kids” Zoey, Alonzo, and Jax.



## **CERA BABB**

**GUEST CONDUCTOR,  
TREBLE CHOIR**

Cera Babb is the Director of Choral Activities and Assistant Professor of Music at the University of Wisconsin-River Falls, where she conducts the Chamber Singers, Concert Choir, and Treble Choir, and teaches courses in conducting and music education. An active clinician with honor choirs and festivals around the country, Babb's work focuses on fostering enriching, meaningful, and musically excellent experiences with musicians and their communities.

Before teaching at UW-River Falls, Babb taught choir and courses in music education and music history at Alma College. She has also worked with nonprofit, community, children's, and intergenerational choirs around the country, and values the impact communal music-making can have on communities of all kinds.

At the start of her career, Babb worked as a Performing Arts Instructor at Sanford School in Hockessin, Delaware. A previous member of Delaware All State herself, she is thrilled to return to DMEA and contribute to its important legacy of music-making. It is a joy to be able to give back to the community that helped her become the musician and person she is today.

Babb's research interests include assessing the impact of choral music on communities, investigating the work of underrepresented musicians, and fostering student success at the post-secondary level. She holds a D.M.A. in Choral Conducting from Michigan State University, a Master of Music in Choral Conducting from the University of Oregon, and a Bachelor of Music in Music Education from the University of Delaware.

Babb is the recipient of the Robert A. Harris Award for Excellence in Choral Performance, the Charles K. Smith Endowed Fellowship in Graduate Choral Conducting, the Graduate Employee Award of Excellence in Ensemble Teaching, and the Johns Award for Excellence in Teaching.



# MICHAEL SEMANCHIK

## GUEST CONDUCTOR, MIXED CHOIR

Michael Semanchik is an Assistant Professor and Director of Choirs and Orchestra at Goucher College in Baltimore, Maryland where he conducts the Chamber Singers, the Goucher Choral Society, and the Orchestra. In addition to his role at Goucher College, he is a doctoral candidate in Choral Conducting at the Mason Gross School of the Arts at Rutgers University, studying with Dr. Patrick Gardner. He earned a M.M. in Choral Conducting at the University of Delaware under the direction of Dr. Paul D. Head and a B.S. in Music Education from Slippery Rock University.

Prior to his enrollment at Rutgers, Michael was the Director of Choral Activities at Morris Knolls High School in Rockaway, New Jersey for 11 years. Under Michael's direction, the Morris Knolls Chorale—one of six choirs featuring over 275 choral students—received extensive awards and performed at a wide range of venues including the White House (2018), Carnegie Hall (2018, 2016, 2014), the American Choral Directors Association Eastern Division Convention (2016), the New Jersey Music Educators State Convention (2014), the National Association for Music Education Eastern Division Convention (2013), and Avery Fisher Hall at Lincoln Center (2012). The choir completed three European tours and performed in concerts at St. Stephen's Cathedral in Vienna, Austria; St. Peter's Church in Riga, Latvia; the Czech Museum of Music in Prague, Czech Republic; Christ Church Cathedral in Dublin, Ireland; St. Anne's Cathedral in Belfast, Northern Ireland; and the Jaani Church in Tallinn, Estonia.

Michael has been the guest conductor of the PMEA Region 1 Mixed Choir (2022), New Jersey Region 1 Mixed Chorus (2022, 2014), PMEA District 1 Honors Tenor/Bass Choir (2019), the New Jersey Region 2 Treble Choir (2018), the New Jersey All-State Treble Choir (2016), and the Sussex County Honor Choir (2011). 

# SIMEONE TARTAGLIONE

## GUEST CONDUCTOR

Schooled in the European tradition covering conducting, composition, opera and chamber music, Simeone Tartaglione has become a versatile musician with a wide knowledge of and passion for the many areas of this art.

He studied composition and conducting in Rome at the Santa Cecilia Conservatory and piano performance in Sicily at the Vincenzo Bellini Institute. In addition to his various degrees and honors, in 2003 he earned a Laurea as Doctor in Philology (Italian Literature and Musicology) Magna cum Laude, and is a published author.

Schooled in the European tradition covering conducting, composition, opera and chamber music, Simeone Tartaglione has become a versatile musician with a wide knowledge of and passion for the many areas of this art. He studied composition and conducting in Rome at the Santa Cecilia Conservatory and piano performance in Sicily at the Vincenzo Bellini Institute. In addition to his various degrees and honors, in 2003 he earned a Laurea as Doctor in Philology (Italian Literature and Musicology) Magna cum Laude, and is a published author.

Tartaglione currently holds a number of positions. At Catholic University in Washington DC he is Associate Professor of Practice, conductor of the Orchestra, Head of Conducting and Orchestral Instruments. He serves as Music Director of the Delaware Youth Symphony Orchestra, Core Orchestral Department Head at the Music School of Delaware in Wilmington, Conductor of the Symphony at the Maryland Classic Youth Orchestras at Strathmore Hall and Artistic Director and Conductor of Musica Viva Kentlands. In May of 2010 he became the Music Director of the Newark (DE) Symphony Orchestra, during which time, this orchestra's audience increased by 63%. The orchestra has also enjoyed record increases in donations, advertisers, and press coverage during this time.

Tartaglione has had extensive conducting experience in symphonic and operatic repertoire with orchestras from Italy, the United States, Spain, Russia, Rumania, Mexico, Ukraine and Bulgaria. He has won numerous competitions and prizes including: Allied Arts, Leon Guide, Athanor, Le Arti, Telamone, Diamante della Musica, Sykele', Rapisarda and Punto fermo. In Rome he served as the Artistic Director of the Theatre Fusillo and of the MUSA Cultural Association for five years.

After winning an audition at the University of Denver he moved there in 2005. At the same university he became Adjunct Professor of Conducting while earning an Artist Diploma. Over the next five years he worked as a guest and cover conductor, vocal coach, pianist and harpsichord player with the Colorado Symphony Orchestra's Education and Outreach Programs, Central City Opera, Marilyn Horne Foundation, Denver Young Artists Orchestra, Colorado Youth Symphony Orchestra, Augustana Musica Sacra Orchestra, and Broadway Music School. He also served as cover conductor for the Colorado Symphony on a number of occasions.

Invited by Maestro Gustav Meier in 2006, Tartaglione moved to Baltimore where he continued conducting studies at the Peabody Conservatory of the Johns Hopkins University earning a Graduate Performing Diploma in 2009 with a conducting assistantship. From 2008 to 2010 he served as Adjunct Faculty for the Peabody Opera Department, coaching and conducting several performances, and most recently served as Music Director for a production of Hansel and Gretel in 2016. In 2009 and 2010, he served as the Music Director of the Be Orchestra, a volunteer group of Peabody and other Baltimore area students and recent graduates that served populations such as the homeless and prisoners. Still in Baltimore he served as conductor of the Chesapeake Chamber Opera conducting several staged productions. Tartaglione also collaborated with Mid-Atlantic Symphony, Peabody Symphony, Peabody Opera, and Hopkins Chorus and on occasions he served as cover and back stage conductor for the Baltimore Opera and the Baltimore Symphony. In November 2019, he conducted Beethoven's 9th Symphony in honor of the 30th Anniversary of The Fall of the Berlin Wall, in the presence of the President of Germany and top United States Government officials. Simeone Tartaglione has recorded several CDs and DVDs as conductor and pianist in duo with his wife, well known violinist Alessandra Cuffaro, the first Italian woman who performed all the 24 Paganini's Capricci in one concert. He and Ms. Cuffaro live in Montgomery County with their two young daughters.



Robert Reynolds, Dr. Glenn D Price, Michael Haithcock, and Dr. Travis Cross. Dr. Hayward has been active in the marching arts as a performer, educator, designer, and adjudicator for over twenty-three years and has won awards at local, state, and regional competitions.
